## SEAS THE DAY

Download the Royal Caribbean International® app before you sail.



**Stay in touch while touching less.  
Don't have the app? Here's what you're missing out on:**

Complete your online check-in and book your arrival time.

Link your credit card to your expense account during online check-in to avoid queues onboard.



Schedule dining reservations and activities with a few taps and build your vacation calendar.

Fast and convenient while avoiding queues.



Track your expense account while onboard.

Expenses are in USD and holds may be placed on your linked credit card. These serve to secure funds for onboard processed transactions and are not actual charges.



Chat with family, friends and other guests onboard.

Charges apply at USD\$1.99 per day and must be purchased for the entire voyage.



The app is available for free from the Apple App Store and Google Play Store. Once onboard, you can use the app for free by connecting to your ship's Guest Wi-Fi network. You do not need to purchase an internet package to use the app. In-app purchases available.



# We're counting down the days until you sail with us!

## Here are your next steps to ensure a smooth and healthy boarding day.

### Before you Arrive

Download your Royal app and complete your [online check-in](#). Ensure that your passport is valid and make sure to check-in on the same day as the rest of your travel party to request the same arrival time.



An email notification for your pre-cruise COVID-19 testing will be sent to you approximately 2 weeks before your sail day. The scheduling and cost of this test will be the guest's responsibility.



Schedule your pre-cruise COVID-19 testing based on the testing options provided in the email in advance on boarding day and ensure you have ample time to arrive at your selected check-in timing upon receiving your negative test results.



Answer the health questions on the app the day before you sail. You'll get an email and app reminder.



Download the TraceTogether app or bring the TraceTogether (TT) token to board the ship. Group check-in for the TT app is not allowed. Everyone needs to have their own TT app/token for check-in. (children under 7 years old are exempted).



Start your mandatory guest safety briefing using your Royal Caribbean app on the day of boarding.



### Boarding Day

Parking space may be limited, so we highly recommend being dropped off at Level 2 of the terminal during your arrival time.



Arrive only during your pre-selected check-in/wellness screening time with your entire travelling party once you have all received your negative COVID-19 test results. All members must check in together. Arriving outside of your appointed time will delay your boarding.



Be sure to keep important items like travel documents, negative test results, and TraceTogether token or app within easy reach. You'll need them when you arrive at the port up to boarding the ship.



Once onboard, report to your assembly station reflected on your Royal Caribbean app to complete your Guest Safety Briefing.


Use a tissue when you cough or sneeze and dispose of it immediately.





Carry your SeaPass card and TraceTogether token or app with Bluetooth turned on at all times.

### Disembarkation



Assigned departure times begin at approximately 7:00 am (refer to the disembarkation letter delivered to your stateroom on the last night for more information).
